**GETAWAYS** 

Dotted along a citrus-treestrung hillside, whitewashed Anassa (3) is as sophisticated as they come. The warm, pellucid waters of Chrysochou Bay (2) are close enough for a pre-breakfast paddle and the stylish suites - some in fragrant gardens, others with their own plunge pools - are the perfect antidote to the scorching Cypriot sun. It's an utter haven for families, while being ever so romantic, with a split-level infinity pool and absurdly spoiling spa.

TASTE

Begin the day on Anassa's vast terrace with an ice-cold frappé and the morning papers and end it in elegant Helios (1), which turns out superb French-Mediterranean à la carte to the genteel sounds of a harpist. A short drive away, family-owned Pavlaras is a great little taverna for a laid-back supper with sigh-inducing views across the bay.

Spa. From the sunny bougainvillea-draped courtyards to the Romanstyle pool, every inch of it has been carefully thought out. Treatments draw on the mind- and body-bolstering benefits of the sea. Ease into the rhythm of it all with a soothing Osea Malibu Lavender Sea Soak before going all out with a glowgiving facial devised by soughtafter skin maestro Tata Harper. If your little ones are keen to get in on the act, there's an all-natural menu of mini treatments, too.

## EXPLORE

With its dramatic gorges, waterfalls and flower-strewn meadows, the Akamas National Park is perfect for hiking and biking; Latchi harbour's bobbing fishing boats and smattering of waterfront tavernas is well worth exploring; and the pristine shores of Lara Bay are home to loggerhead turtles. Back at the hotel, there are insightful wine tastings with the inhouse sommelier as well as stargazing sessions down on the sand.
